Due to an increased interest in the classes offered at the Verona Senior Center we find it necessary to initiate a Residency Policy to insure that City of Verona participants are not excluded from classes due to high enrollment of interested individuals from outside the City. While it is the commitment of the City of Verona and the Verona Senior Center to provide the highest level of services, programs, and activities for area adults, it is absolutely essential that City residents be given first priority in access to all City owned facilities. To the fullest extent possible the Senior Center will expand class sizes and increase offerings to be sure that everyone who wants to participate has that opportunity, but again, the first obligation is rightfully to serve residents of the City of Verona. We will therefore begin an immediate policy of pre-registration for City residents with any remaining slots in classes or programs available on a first-come basis to all interested others. The pre-registration and open registration dates will be included in all class announcements. We are extremely proud of the quality of programs and classes provided by the Verona Senior Center and gratified that the quality is reflected in the high level of interest. We are confident this Residency Policy affords the fairest distribution of class spaces.
